Subi Church has three weekend services and a diversity of ministries that take place during the week.

The Role

Subi Church is looking for a Youth & Young Adults Pastor to provide leadership, strategic planning, implementation and allocation of resources to disciple high-schoolers, university students and young professionals through the Subi Youth and Subi Young Adults ministries.

NOTE: Subi Youth and Subi Young Adults are connected yet distinct ministries. Anyone who can only commit to part-time ministry in one of these ministries are encouraged to apply.

This pastoral role involves:

- Leading a dedicated team of young adults to guide and build up the Subi Youth ministry (highschoolers); and
- Overseeing, equipping, and ministering to the Subi Young Adults (18-30+ years-old).

In addition, you may be asked to preach, lead communion, or participate in other areas of corporate worship.

Requirements

- A person of the Word and of prayer
- Suitable theological qualification from a recognized Christian seminary (or currently undertaking theological training).
- In agreement with and a commitment to upholding Subi Church's Statement of Faith.
- Good interpersonal and leadership skills.
- Has a valid or can attain a Working With Children Check and/or National Police Clearance.
- Has a right to live and work in Australia.

Key Relationships

- Church staff and Elders – This position is directly accountable to the Lead Pastor.
- Parents of youth – the primary discipleship responsibility belongs to Christian parents, therefore it is essential for the Youth Ministry team to maintain strong relationships with parents.
- Adult volunteers – work alongside adults who disciple, mentor and teach youth and young adults.
- Volunteer Youth leaders and Young Adult leaders – recruit, equip and enable them to lead.
- Youth and Young Adults – as a godly role model seek opportunities for mentoring, pastoral care and spiritual involvement in the lives of Subi Youth and Young Adults.

Additional Information

- This position is a full-time position. A potential candidate who is able to commit to part-time ministry only, due current theological studies, is also encouraged to apply.
- 2-year fixed term contract with a 3-month probationary period.
