




What is AWANA Club?

AWANA is an international, Bible-centred ministry founded over 60 years ago by Christian men who saw a need for children to be reached with the good news of Jesus Christ. AWANA has grown from its beginnings in a church basement in the Chicago area into a ministry that reached hundreds of thousands of children around the world each week.

AWANA Fun Facts:

- AWANA clubs meet each week both in the US and internationally.
- AWANA has reached over 2 million children worldwide.
- Over 28,000 churches use the AWANA program.
- AWANA can be found in over 100 countries.

AWANA Purpose:

AWANA stands for Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed and is taken from 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

The key focus of AWANA ministry is Scripture memorization, understanding and application. The AWANA handbooks clearly present the Gospel at an age-appropriate level, and initially focus on establishing a personal relationship between each clubber and Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. The memory work, Bible studies and other fun activities continue to carefully give each clubber a Biblical worldview by building up their Bible knowledge and instilling in them a love and respect for God and His Word.

AWANA curriculum materials are designed to help parents and churches guide children in spiritual growth, and are based on the following master life threads:

- Teaching respect for God and His Word
- Building wisdom through Bible knowledge and understanding
- Helping children and youth demonstrate grace in relationships § Giving them a sense of destiny and purpose
- Encouraging them to see things from God's perspective

Who can participate in AWANA?

AWANA at Subi Church is open to any child, regardless of whether they regularly attend our church, another church, or no church at all. AWANA clubs are available for preschool age children (at least 3 year old, potty-trained) all the way up to YEAR 6.

All leaders must complete an AWANA Volunteer Application and have a Working With Children Check. AWANA leaders are trained in the AWANA curriculum and disciplinary system and child to leader ratios.

AWANA Parent Involvement

Our goal as an AWANA ministry is to help and equip parents as they guide their family's spiritual development. We strongly encourage you to work with your child in their AWANA handbook! Help them memorize the Bible verse(s) and talk with them about what that verse means and how they can use it in their life. Read the Bible passages and answer the questions as a family. Use your children's handbooks for family devotions, or have a family Scripture memory contest! The handbooks have tools and practical suggestions to help you as you learn and study together. Just a few minutes a day can yield eternal rewards!

Find what incentives work for your child! We will offer incentives and awards throughout the program but you can also reward your child for meeting your expectations as well!

Parents are invited to visit in their child's club anytime! Just be sure to stop by the Check-In Desk and let us know.

Deuteronomy 11:18-21, God instructs parents to... "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Write them on the door frames of your houses and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors, as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth."



Parent Expectations

- Make sure your child(ren) arrive on time with their uniform, handbook, Bible, water bottle, athletic shoes, and jacket if needed.
- Make AWANA a priority in your plans. Be committed to working with your child(ren) at home and encourage and congratulate them on their accomplishments.
- Serve as handbook helper, packing away or in other ways.
- Pray for our church, AWANA club, leaders and clubbers.



AWANA Club Overview



AWANA Cubbies is for preschool children who are eligible for Pre-Kindy and Kindy and are potty-trained. Cubbies' parents work directly with their children throughout the week in the scheduled handbook section as active participants in their child's spiritual development. Children learn key truths about God, Jesus, salvation and the Bible through memorizing shortened passages of Scripture as well as games and activities. All Cubbies will begin in the Apple Acres Entrance Booklet. Once they complete the Apple Acre book, Cubbies will receive their uniform vest and AWANA Handbook (to be purchased). Cubbies will work together on the same handbook section each week. If your child is absent, he or she can choose to make up the missed sections. As clubbers progress, through their handbooks, they earn award patches to display on their blue vests.

AWANA Cubbies rotation includes Worship, Games/Activities, Lesson, and Small Group/Handbook time. Worship is in the auditorium with the entire club. All other rotational activities are in the Cubbies room (Preschool Room 3 downstairs).

Lastly, we ask that all Cubbies parents remain in the area for the duration of the club meeting.

*Cubbies will be dismissed from the auditorium. Parents must collect their child no later than 7:00pm. If a friend or family member will be picking up your child, please notify us in writing and on the registration form.



Sparks Club is for children in Pre-Primary - Year 2. The Sparks program contains memory verses of gradually increasing difficulty, teaching children more about Jesus, God and His Word. Sparks' Handbooks provide a complete overview of the Bible from Genesis - Revelation and coincide with the year each clubber is in:

- Pre-Primary-Hang Glider Book: Genesis-Joshua
- Year 1- Wing Runner-: Judges-birth of Christ
- Year 2- Sky Stormer: birth of Christ-Revelation



All children in the Sparks program will begin by completing the Flight 3:16 booklet. Once they complete the Flight 3:16 booklet, they will receive their uniform vest and handbook (to be purchased). Clubbers can complete more than 1 section per week. In order to receive all available awards, clubbers must recite the address (book, chapter, verse) and the verse itself.

AWANA Sparks rotation includes Opening Assembly, Games, Large Group Lesson Time, and Small Group/Handbook time.

*Sparks Clubbers will be dismissed from the auditorium. Parents must pick up their child no later than 7:00pm. If a friend or family member will be picking up your child, please notify us in writing and on the registration form.



AWANA Truth and Training Club is for Years 3 - 6 and is exactly what the name implies: teaching boys and girls the truth of God's Word and training them to follow God and live lives of grace. T&T uses four different handbooks on a four year cycle.

These are the 4 different handbooks, ideally, a clubber will complete 1 per year.

T&T Grace in Action T&T Mission: Grace in Action engages kids by answering their questions about God and the Bible while guiding them to grow in Christ's love and live out their faith.

T&T Evidence of Grace In Evidence of Grace, T&T kids will explore some of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity. They will spend time learning about the character and nature of God, the structure and sequence of the Bible, the redemption narrative, and key discipleship practices.

T&T Agents of Grace
In Mission: Agents of Grace, children discover how to be Agents of Grace by learning about the attributes of God, the importance of biblical theology and the seven "I AM" statements of Jesus Christ from the Gospel of John.

T&T Discovery of Grace In *Discovery of Grace*, kids in 3rd through 6th grade explore the meaning of God's grace and how it affects their lives. Topics include:

Attributes of God, why God gave us the Bible, the events of Jesus'



death and resurrection and the result of God's grace in our lives as seen through the fruits of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22-23

All Clubbers will begin in the Start Zone entrance book. Once they complete the Start Zone book, clubbers will receive their uniform and handbook (to be purchased). Clubbers can complete more than 1 section per week. In order to receive all available awards, clubbers must recite the address (book, chapter, verse) and the verse itself. They must complete all fill in the blanks and any other activities in that section

AWANA T&T rotation includes Opening Assembly, Small Group/Handbook time, Games, and Large Group Lesson Time.

*T&T Clubbers will be dismissed from the auditorium. Parents must pick up their child no later than 7:00pm. If a friend or family member will be picking up your child, please notify us in writing and on the registration

AWANA Club Meeting Information

Subi AWANA Club meets from 5:30pm-7:00pm on Tuesday evenings during the school year; a schedule will be posted online. The club meeting begins promptly at 5:30pm. Check-in will begin at 5:20pm. Cubbies will check in for attendance at the check in table, but will earn "points" for uniform, book, bringing friends etc in their Cubbies class. Sparks and T&T will receive AWANA store points at check in.

All clubs meet in the sanctuary at 5:30pm for worship and then follow a rotation for the activities below (Sparks and T&T only, Cubbies have a slight variation of this):



Game Time: high energy, exciting games played outdoors or indoors on the AWANA game circle. Game time promotes fun, exercise, good sportsmanship, and an opportunity to excel. Winning teams receive AWANA Store points and special recognition.

Small Group/Handbook Time: Clubbers work in small groups with other clubbers in their club and with a leader. The leader will lead the small group time and help clubbers review their verses. The leader and listeners will listen to completed sections and sign-off in their handbooks. After a section is completed, the clubber will receive AWANA points and will be able to spend it in the Awana store at the end of the yea





Large Group Lesson Time: An interactive, age-appropriate Bible lesson, worship and/or prayer time. Large Group Lesson will include the Gospel presentation and other biblical truths. At the end of Large Group Lesson time, clubbers will receive their awards for the week.

Theme Nights An email will be distributed to announce Theme Nights! Theme Nights may include Crazy Hair Night, PJ Night, or Glow in the Dark Night. Clubbers who participate will receive extra AWANA store points!

What to wear Each clubber should wear their AWANA uniform or vest each night to receive recognition and incentives. In addition, please have your clubber wear pants or shorts and ATHLETIC SHOES with ties or Velcro. Please note that ATHLETIC SHOES with ties or Velcro are required for your child to participate in Game Time. Croc, sandals, flip-flops/thongs, boots and bare feet can cause injury to your child as well as other children. Please help us with this concern and have a pair of sneakers available for your clubber on Tuesday nights!

AWANA Discipline System, Awards, and Registration Costs

AWANA Discipline System

All leaders and helpers are trained in the AWANA Discipline System.

- 5 Count-Used to quiet or bring order to an entire group. The person in charge initiates the 5- count by holding up one hand and slowly counting from 1-5. At the count of 5, all clubbers and leaders should be quiet and paying attention.
- 3 Count-Used for children not following club behaviour standards. If a clubber receives three warnings for improper behaviour in one club meeting, the clubbers' parents will be asked to pick him or her up. He or she may return to club the following week by agreeing to abide by club rules.

AWANA Awards

Cubbies, Sparks, and T&T clubbers have the opportunity to earn awards throughout the year (patches, pins, plaques, etc). Clubbers receive their awards during Large Group Time. The handbook will explain the awards for that particular club and how they should be worn. Clubbers may also earn AWANA shares (store points) during check-in, game time, and handbook time.

Registration Costs

AWANA is a free program and that includes all awards, however, the AWANA Handbooks.

Uniforms and bags must be purchased once your child has completed their entrance booklet.

Awana Cubbies® celebrates the spiritual potential of preschoolers by helping them develop respect for God, His Son, and His Word. Lessons (called Bear Hugs) include memory verses, Bible lessons, and activities that teach basic core truths about God, lesus, and salvation. Multiple options allow leaders to choose what works best for their group. Creative learning activities encourage parent-child interaction at home.


